

**WAMATYC Business Meeting Notes**

**Friday May 18, 2018**

Paul Casillas opened the meeting with a review of the minutes from the May 2017. Chris Milner moved to approve the minutes with some minor corrections, Dan Taylor seconded. Approved by acclamation

Chris Milner presented the treasurer's report:

Paul presented a report on the WAMATYC session at the conference. It was nicely attended and an honorarium to the speaker was presented. Suggestions for personnel for future talks was given Luke Rawlings, Yves Nievergelt were two suggestions offered.

Paul announced we would give out two WAMATYC awards that evening.

At the chairs meeting there was a discussion of possibly offering an AST degree in mathematics. This helps with students who need to transfer after 90 credits and do not have space for the numerous

electives in the AA degree. The general feeling is that we should pursue this with SBCTC to understand the process to propose this degree.

Pete Wildman reminded everyone that AMATYC national will be in Spokane in 2020. Nov. 12–15 at the Davenport Grand Hotel (and Convention Center) in Spokane.

A discussion of AMATYC scholarships was presented

- a) There is student scholarship. All that is required is to send a letter to the president and the name is selected randomly and sent to AMATYC. The first year the scholarship was offered it went to a student from Washington. Paul sent a nice letter and book to all who were nominated this year.
- b) There is an instructor scholarship for someone to attend AMATYC national in Orlando. Primarily designed for a first-time attendee. Watch for e-mail in the future

There was a discussion about moving the bank from Bank of America to another bank. WAMATYC will investigate this option
